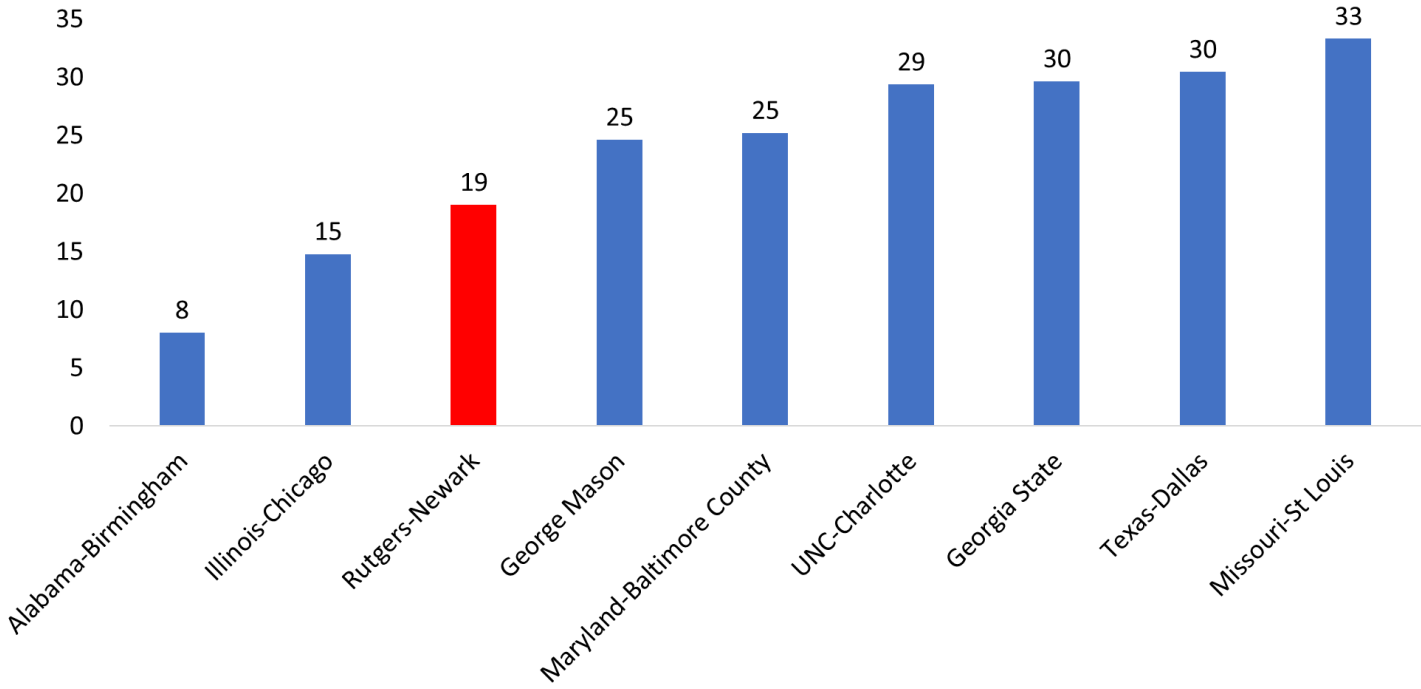
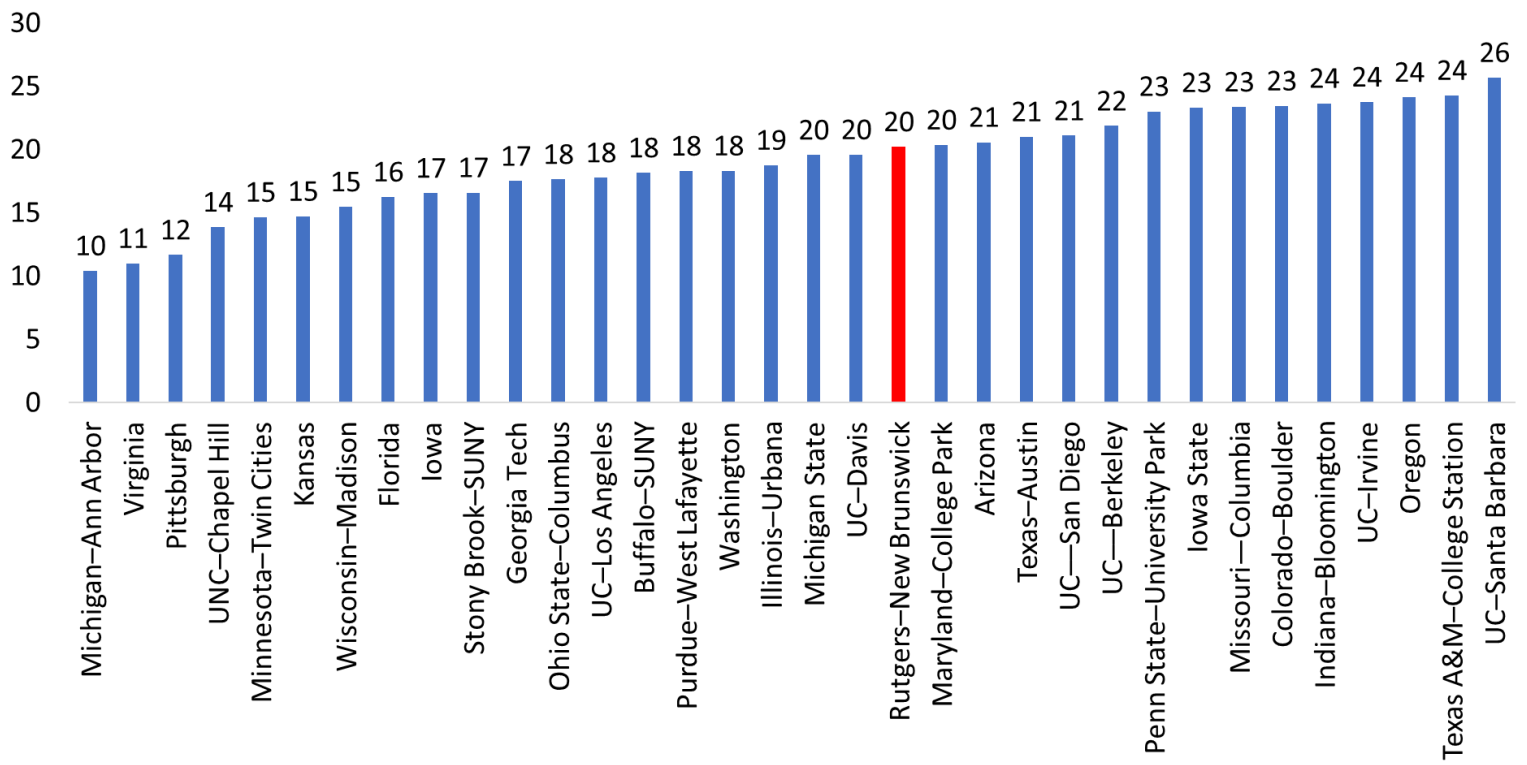

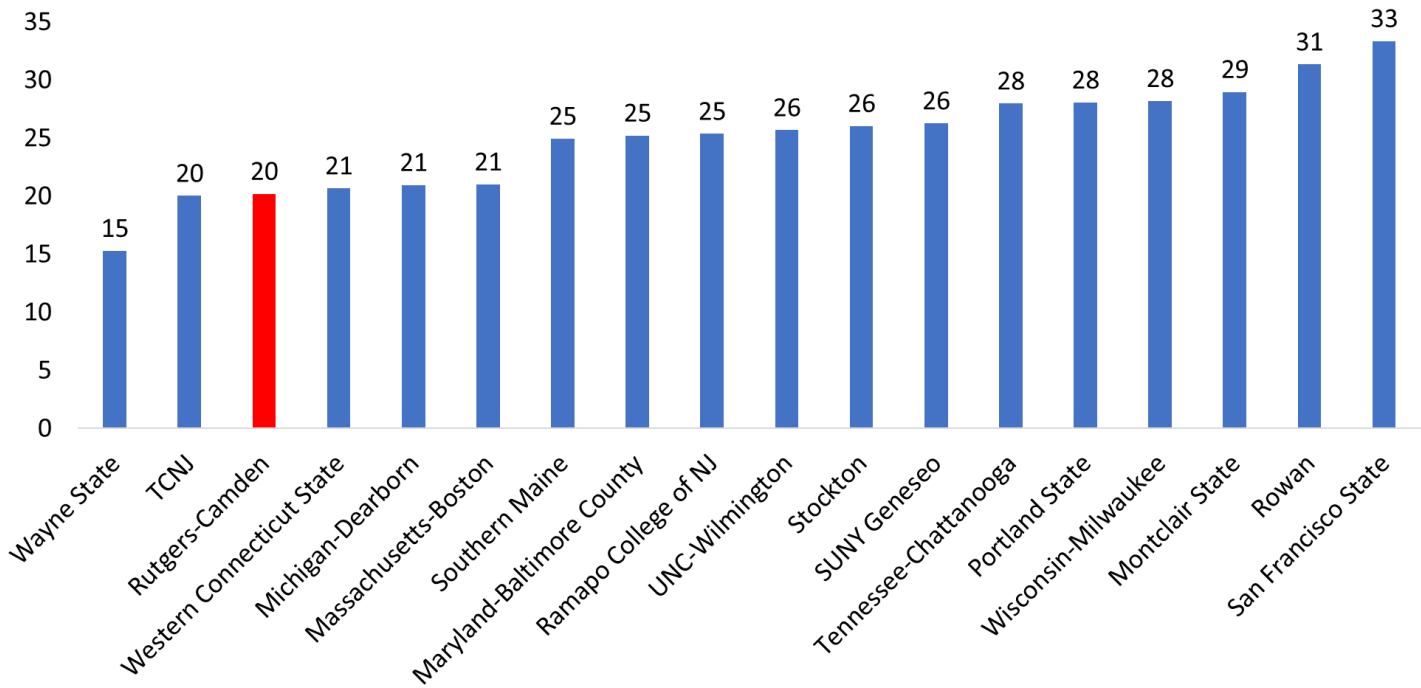
Student-Faculty Ratio for Rutgers-Newark & Peers

Notes:

- 1) Student-Faculty ratio is calculated as the undergraduate full-time equivalent (FTE) divided by full-time tenure/tenure track instructional faculty. Full-Time instructional faculty includes both medical and non-medical faculty, and includes faculty from both undergraduate and graduate/professional schools.
- 2) There are alternative methods for a Student-Faculty Ratio calculation. An IPEDS reported Student-Faculty Ratio reflects both undergraduate and graduate enrollment, and excludes enrollment and faculty from graduate/professional schools in which faculty have little contact with undergraduate students.
