HELLO AGAIN!

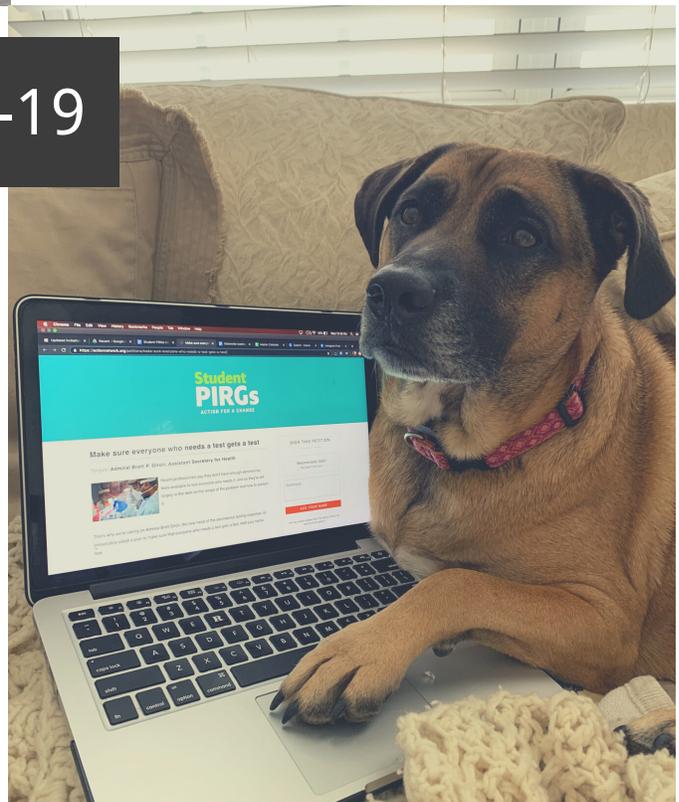
We hope you and your loved ones are staying safe and healthy during these unprecedented and uneasy times.
