I am writing to acknowledge receipt of the University Senate's report and resolution on Charge S-1905: Teaching Loads. I appreciate the work of the Faculty and Personnel Affairs Committee in exploring the possibility of defining a normal teaching load across Rutgers.

As the Senate has affirmed the committee's recommendation against establishing a standard Rutgers teaching load and instead leave the matter to schools and departments as is the current practice, I do not intend to issue a formal response at this time.
