

Whereas the Covid 19 pandemic has necessitated re-scheduling of some classes
to avoid large crowds,

whereas some evening classes are extended well into the night,
sometimes
beyond 10:30 pm, and which this decision may have caused great
inconvenience
to both faculty and particularly students, and possibly could have
compromised
their safety,

be it resolved that

1) The university administration should continue to take temporary
measures to
safeguard the Rutgers students, faculty, and staff so as to minimize
the
dangers of Covid-19 infection and spread.

2) The university administration should continue to schedule classes
during the
Covid-19 pandemic in a manner that ensures the safety of students,
faculty, and staff.

3) The university should not implement the class scheduling in a
manner that
would cause extreme inconvenience to students and faculty, and that
introduces
new risks and dangers to them.

4) The university administration must consult the decanal units and
departments and consider their input in any of these temporary
changes in
class scheduling.

5) The university administration should not make any of these
pandemic-related
changes permanent without consultation with and consent of the decanal
units and departments.
