

## Rutgers University Senate Resolution on Doxxing February 2024

WHEREAS, there have been instances of unwarranted and harmful exposure (doxxing) and harassment of members of the Rutgers community, which are contrary to the principles of free speech, freedom of expression, and academic liberty;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Rutgers University Senate urges the Rutgers administration to take more proactive and effective measures to protect members of the Rutgers community from being doxxed and harassed for exercising their right to free speech, and to support those who have already been targeted;

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that the Rutgers University Senate encourages the Rutgers administration to provide comprehensive support to students, staff, and faculty members who have been publicly maligned or defamed. This support should include, but not be limited to, academic assistance, mental health services, and legal resources to ensure their well-being and the continuation of their academic and professional pursuits without fear of retribution or stigma.
