Re: Response to Senate Charge S-2324 Investigate Sunsetting of Academic Credit
Across Campuses and Review Any Proposed Changes

I am writing in response to the University Senate's report and recommendations on Charge S-2324 Investigate Sunsetting of Academic Credit Across Campuses and Review Any Proposed Changes. I have consulted with the appropriate offices and provide a summary of their responses below. As always, the University welcomes feedback from the University Senate in the interest of continual improvement.

Recommendations: Individual school's websites should be updated, when necessary, with its current policy on this subject and should provide easy-to-follow directions for re-enrollment, and credit evaluation. Individual schools should set up a designated contact person in each school's academic dean's office with email for follow-up and next steps. Sufficient funds should be allocated for website updates and staff personnel involved in this process. Updates should emphasize the University's continuing commitment to non-traditional students and that helping and encouraging these students to complete their degrees remains a high priority.

The university is providing more comprehensive information to students who are considering re-enrollment in academic programs. This includes detailed guidance on the re-enrollment process, key contacts for assistance, and support services available to facilitate a productive and successful return to Rutgers.

As noted in the Academic Standards, Regulations, and Admissions Committee's response to Charge S-2324 to the University Senate, Rutgers Biomedical and Health Sciences does not have a uniform re-enrollment process due to the unique requirements of many of its programs. However, the [Ernest Mario School of Pharmacy](#) and the [School of Nursing](#) provide students considering re-enrollment with the information, processes, and support to help them pursue the completion of a degree.
