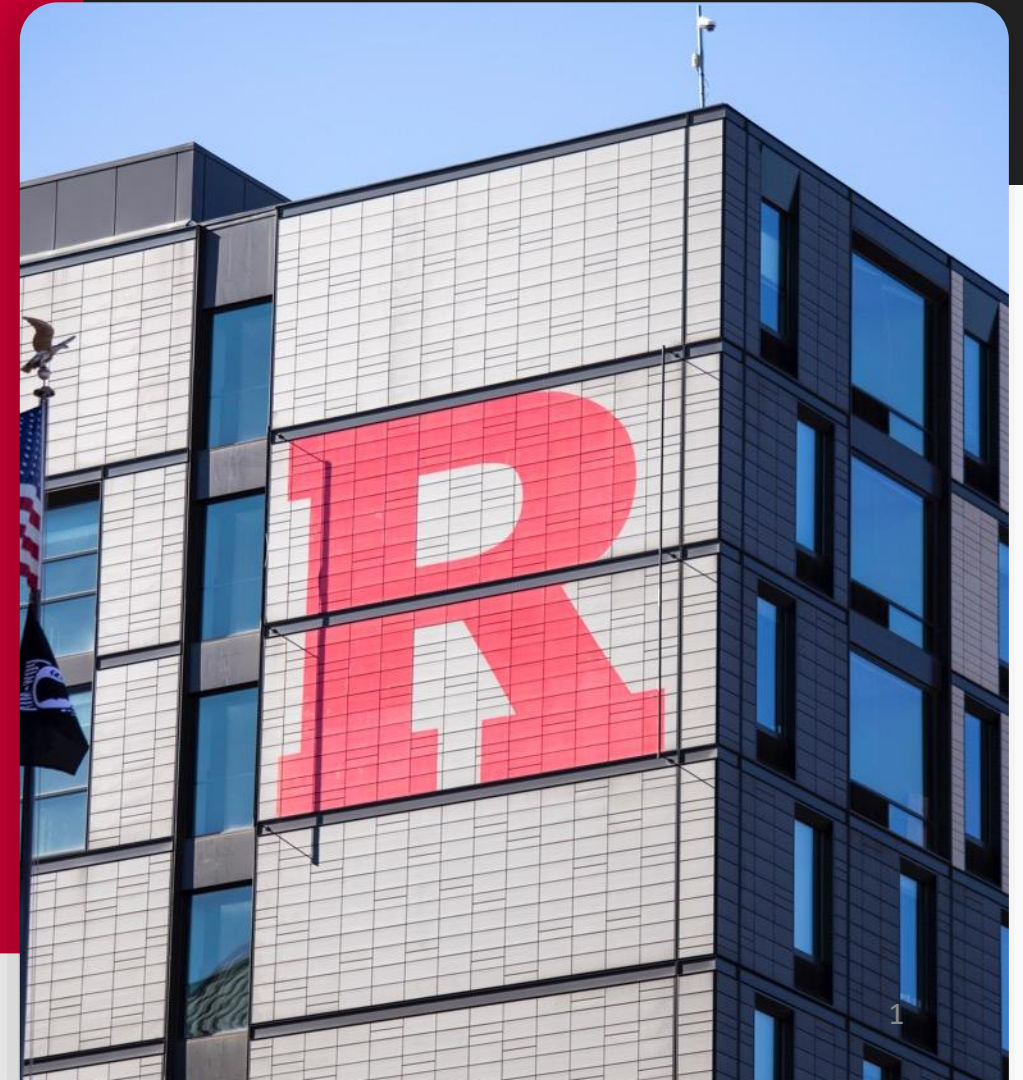

Because we are a small, engaged community, students participate in cutting-edge faculty research from as early as their sophomore year.

- Other/Unknown: 4.3%

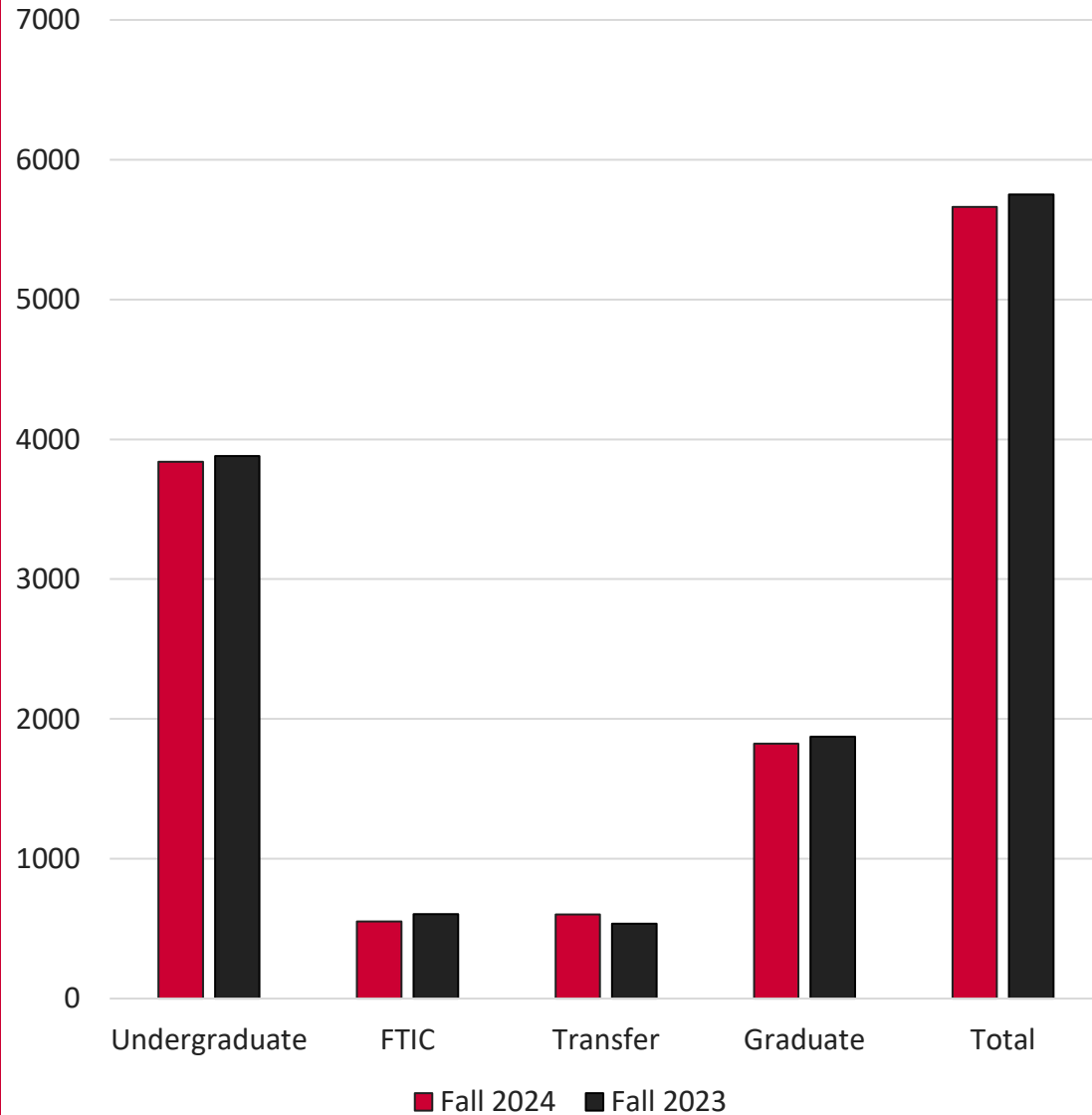
